- 3. Taking a video of coral reef protection and restoration;
- 4. Taking a picture on collaborative conservation and the sustainable use of mangroves;
- 5. Writing a letter to your government about the need for marine protected areas:
- 6. Creating a flyer on raising awareness of the impacts of ocean acidification;
- 7. Developing a video on what sustainable blue economy means to your country;
