The Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Trade & Export Development of Grenada presents its compliments to the Commonwealth Secretariat in London and wishes to inform that Hurricane Beryl made landfall on the State of Grenada as a Category 4 hurricane on Monday, July 1st, 2024.

Preliminary reports indicate that Hurricane Beryl had devastating effects on Grenada, especially throughout the sister islands of Carriacou and Petite Martinique, where the National Disaster Management Agency (NaDMA) estimates that 98% of structures have been damaged or destroyed. The northern parishes of the mainland of Grenada report significant infrastructural and agricultural devastation which is currently impacting our food and water supplies.

Due to the emergency situation in Grenada, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs has the honour to inform that a Natural Disaster Fund has been established where financial contributions in support of the hurricane relief effort can be made to facilitate the Government of Grenada in the country's recovery and restoration efforts following the hurricane. Banking information is provided in the attached leaflet.

This phenomenon serves as a glaring reminder of the realities of climate change and its adverse effects on Small Island Developing States (SIDS). We call on our international partners for humanitarian and developmental assistance during these unfortunate circumstances as collective action and solidarity is needed in our rebuilding efforts.
