The Chairman of the Commonwealth Observer Group General Abdulsalami A. Abubakar condemns the heinous suicide attack that took place this morning near a polling station in Quetta, Balochistan Province, in Pakistan, which claimed at least 31 lives in addition to causing numerous injuries.

He said: "This attack must not undermine the democratic exercise currently underway in Pakistan. We continue to stand in solidarity with the people of Pakistan today as they exercise their franchise."
